## 06. Evaluation

## 6.1 Testing of a Course Unit

- A course unit may be evaluated by examination, assignments, reports, and presentations.
- The examinations of all course units are held at the end of the respective year.

6.2 Grading System

Marks obtained in respect of a course unit will be graded according to a twelve category grading system as follows:

Students should complete all course units of the Degree. In case of failure to produce valid reasons for not completing a particular course unit a grade of 'E' will be given.

#### 6.3 Computation of Grade Point Average

Grade Point Average (GPA) is the creditweighted arithmetic mean of the Grade Point Values, ie, the GPA is determined by dividing the total credit-weighted Grade Point Value by the total number of credits.

GPA shall be computed to the second decimal place

For an example, a student who has completed six course units with grades A, C, B+, D, E, A+ would have the GPA,

$$5 \times 4.0 + 5 \times 2.0 + 5 \times 3.3 + 5 \times 1.0 + 5 \times 0.0 + 5 \times 4.0$$

$$5+5+5+5+5$$

$$= 20.0+10.0+16.5+5.0+0.0+20.0$$

$$= 71.5 \frac{30}{30} = 2.38333$$

$$= 2.38$$

All course units shall be taken into account (except BMGT E1075 - English for Business Communication) in calculating the GPA for the award of degree.

# 7. Criteria for Award of the Degree 7.1 Pass

A candidate may be awarded the Bachelor of Business Management (General) Degree (External) if he/she has satisfied the following requirements,

- Obtained, in respect of the course units taken into consideration in the computation of the GPA, grades of C or better in course units aggregating to at least 75 credits, and grades of D, D+ or C- in course units aggregating to not more than five (05) credits from each year,
- ii. Obtained a minimum GPA of 2.00,
- Obtained grade C or better in course unit entitled English for Business Communication (BMGT E1075)

and

 Completed the relevant requirements within a period of five academic years.

#### 7.2 Award of Class

#### (a) First Class Honours

A candidate may be awarded First Class Honours provided he/she has

- Obtained, in respect of the course units taken into consideration in the computation of GPA, grades of C or better in course units aggregating to at least 80 credits with grade of A or better in course units aggregating to at least 45 credits.
- ii. Obtained a minimum GPA of 3.70,
- Obtained grade C or better in course unit entitled English for Business Communication (BMGT E1075),

#### and

iv. Completed the relevant requirements within three academic years.

### (b) Second Class (Upper Division) Honours

A candidate may be awarded second Class (Upper division) Honours provided he/she has

- v. Obtained, in respect of the course units taken into consideration in the computation of GPA, grades of C or better in course units aggregating to at least 80 credits with grade of A or better in course units aggregating to at least 45 credits.
- vi. Obtained a minimum GPA of 3.30,

vii. Obtained grade C or better in course unit entitled English for Business Communication (BMGT E1075)

and

viii. Completed the relevant requirements within 3 academic years.

#### (c) Second Class (Lower Division) Honours

A candidate may be awarded second Class (Lower division) Honours provided he/she has

- Obtained, in respect of the course units taken into consideration in the computation of GAP, grades of C or better in course units aggregating to at <u>least 75</u> credits with grade of B or better in course units aggregating to at least 45 credits and grades of D, D+ or C- in the remaining course units aggregating not more than 5 credits from each year,
- ii. Obtained a minimum GPA of 3.00,
- iii. Obtained grade C or better in course unit entitled English for Business Communication, (BMGT E1075) and
- iv. Completed the relevant requirements within 3 academic years.

#### 08. Re-sit Examination

A student who obtains either a 'C-', 'D+', 'D' or an 'E' in a particular course unit may re-sit the examination in respect of the course unit for the purpose of improving the grade; the best grade obtainable in this instance is 'C'. In the event a student obtains a lower grade while attempting to better the grade, he/she will be entitled to the previous best grade.
