1. On the acquisition date, building of Blexa Ltd has been revalued for Rs. 2,800,000. As at 31.03.2021, Blexa ltd books shows following balances.

Building - Rs. 3,000,000

Provision for depreciation of building - Rs. 600,000.

Blexa ltd depreciate their asset at 5% rate on straight line basis.

- 2. During the year Blexa Ltd sold, Rs. 600,000 cost of goods to Alexa Ltd with 20% gross profit margin. 15% of such goods remained in Alexa Ltd's inventory as at 31.03.2021
- 3. During the year Alexa Ltd sold goods valued at Rs. 700,000 to Blexa Ltd. Cost of these goods to Alexa Ltd was Rs. 600,000. 10% of such goods remained in Blexa Ltd's inventory as at 31.03.2021
- 4. On 01st October 2020 Blexa Ltd obtained a 10% interest bearing loan amounting to Rs. 250,000 from Alexa ltd with an agreement to repay it within next twelve month period.
- 5. During the year it was identified an unrecorded cash amount of Rs. 120,000 by Alexa Ltd. It is a cash payment made by Blexa ltd on 30th March 2021 as a settlement of the amount due to Alexa.

On 30th June 2021 the company went into liquidation and as per the requirement of section 283 of the Companies Act No. of 2007 the secretary of the company is going to submit the statement of company affairs and other documents by using following information.

i. Assets realized values

Land-Rs,4,500,000 Building-Rs.8,100,000 Plant & Machinery –Rs.33,750,000 Equipments-Rs.2,160,000 Stock-Rs.6,750,000

- ii. Accrued interests of loan on mortgages should pay up to 30th June 2021.Interest up to 31st March 2021 paid in full.
- iii. Based on the cash receipts of trade debtor's they have been analyzed them as good debtors, doubtful debtors and bad debtors. The amount of each Category of debtors are as follows.

Good Debtors - Rs.9,900,000 Doubtful Debtors -Rs.4,725,000 (estimated to realize 75%) Rest of the debtors will be treated as bad debtors

- iv. Company has called arrears money from the shareholders, and it is estimated to realize Rs.67,500 from them
- v. Including late charges Rs.1,080,000 should be paid to the creditors.
- vi. Director agrees to receive Rs.630,000 as his accrued salary.
- vii. Other liabilities, except creditors and directors' accrued salary, have to be settled in full as per the statement of financial position.
- viii. Company received Rs.99,000 from an unrecorded debtor.
- ix. There is a contingent liability for legal payment Rs.112,500 and estimated to be realized for Rs.99,000
- x. Retaining earning balance as at 31.03.2021 occurred as a result of following reasons.

2016/17 - Company had Rs.23,400,000 trade profit and Rs. 4,500,000 general reserve. At the year end they declared Rs.6,300,000 ordinary share and preference share dividends.

2017/18 - Company had Rs.2,250,000 trade profit at the end of the year and they faced a stock loss of.Rs.90,000. They declared Rs.4,950,000 of ordinary share and preference share dividends.

2018/19 - Company had Rs.900,000 trade loss and at the end of the year they declared Rs.4,006,000 preference share dividends.

2019/20 - Company had Rs.11,250,000 trade loss and at the end of the year they declared Rs.4,006,000 preference share dividends.

2020/21 - Company had Rs.11,520,000 trade loss and at the end of the year they declared Rs.4,006,000 preference share dividends.
