Sinha Tyre Company Ltd.

Sinha tyre company Ltd. is producing tyres for bicycles and threewheels, as it's main business. It functioned successfully until recent and had a good reputation of providing quality and durable tires in the market. But the company is now suffering from serious labour disputes and corruption. This has led to the reductions of its market, since quality and durability of its products have decreased over the period. The cost of production has also been increasing. Some domestic and foreign products have already entered to the market and increasing the competition to the company.

A new board of directors have been appointed with the aim of bringing the firm back to its earlier success. They are now investigating the present situation and analysing ways to come out with a solution. They have brought following findings form their investigation.

- I. The average cost of production is higher than that of industry and of which higher percentage is composed of administration cost.
- II. There are many middle level managers than required and most of time they are found to be idle in the company.
- III. There are some low-level managers than required and their functions seem to be limited only to supervise the employees.
- IV. Most of employees are intelligent, able and skilled labourers and Job satisfaction is very low among them. This is due to the fact that they are closely supervised and lock of autonomy in doing jobs.
- V. There is a quality control system but it is totally up to the management of the company. The employee involvement can't be seen in this process.
- VI. Upward communication was blocked. This has led to feeling of distrust, and hostile among employee towards management.
- VII. A autocratic leadership style has been prevailed in the firm and employee participation is not allowed in decision making.
